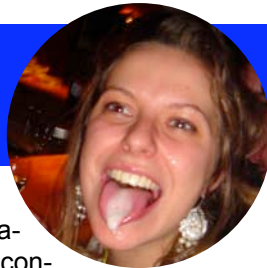

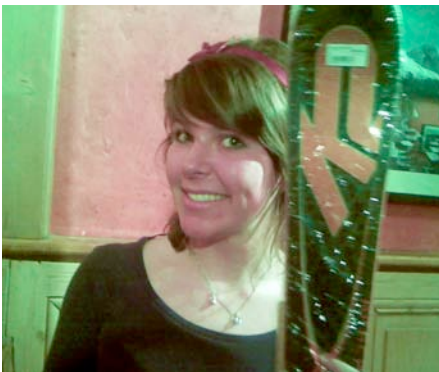
# Debbie Does.....

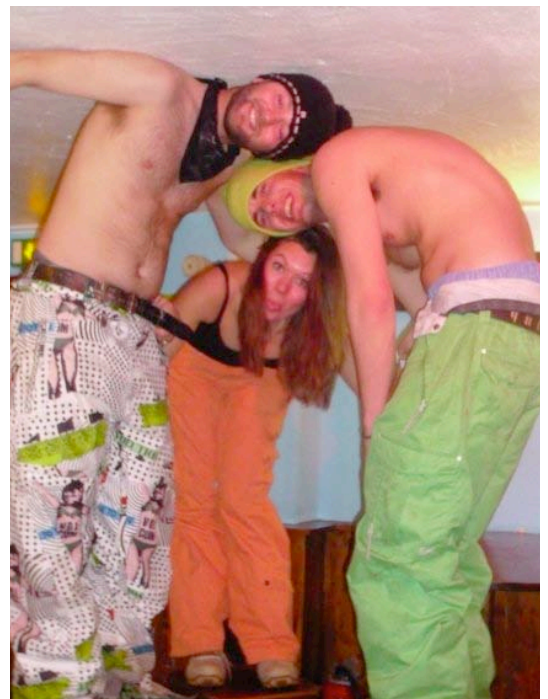
