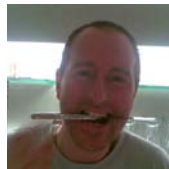

Texas hold em Poker

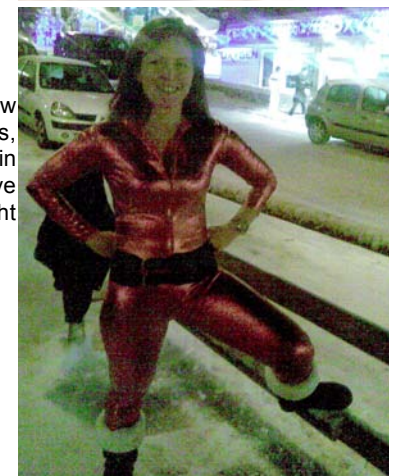
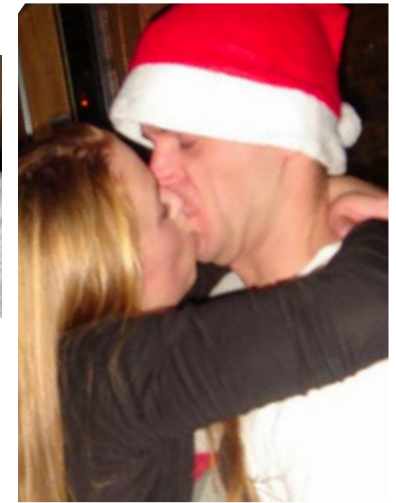
